All about the "Blume"

It's always worth a visit: Baden's industrial and bathing traditions and the medieval town centre. The first train line in Switzerland and to date the most modern occupational education centre (for those interested in architecture). Swiss Children's museum, Roman settlement or the bathing tradition in the Historical Museum, the Impressionist and living museum. Industrial culture trail and hikes on the Lägern ridge (tranquil route or on the rock ridge!). ABB historical sites or the Trafo Cinema complex, a Europe-wide showpiece for its infrastructure. Arrival by car
